Teaching and training mobility Erasmus+

Call for application 2022-2023

What is an Erasmus+ mobility?

This is a mobility that allows any member of staff from partner universities to carry out a training or teaching activity at the Université Savoie Mont Blanc (USMB) as part of the Erasmus+International Credit Mobility (ICM) project.

Eligible activities for training mobility are: "any activity that supports the professional development of the participant in the form of training events, observation periods in a work situation in a university or in any other partner organization of the project".

The duration of the project is 5 full days of on-site training (excluding travel days).

What are the offered mobility opportunities in USMB?

-Training mobility or Teaching mobility within the framework of the "Summer Modules for Intercultural and Language Education" (S.M.I.L.E) [in French "Semaine des Langues"] from June 19 to 24, 2023.

This event brings together many international partners for language courses, meetings, networking, cultural activities ...

How is the mobility financed?

A grant including "travel" costs (€1500) + "living" costs (€160/day) will be allocated by the Erasmus+ ICM program in accordance with the applicable European rates, for a maximum of one week of mission (5 days of on-site activities + 2 days of travel), i.e. a total package of €2620.

Attention: Any additional costs of participating in the chosen activities will not be covered by the USMB. They will have to be paid by the participants directly.

How is the mission managed?

Mobility will be managed as a mission by the participant's home university. A letter of invitation will be issued by the USMB's International Relations Department (DRI) to obtain a visa, if necessary. The grant will be paid directly to the participant to cover his/her travel, subsistence expenses and any costs related to participation in the chosen event.

A grant agreement and an Erasmus+ learning agreement (Mobility Kit) must be completed with the support of the DRI and your university, and signed by the participant, the home institution and the USMB, before the departure on mobility.

Upon return, the participant must complete a participant report and provide a certificate of attendance. They may be asked to participate in the promotion and sharing of their international experience.
